### • Maintain punctuality

#### Introductions

#### • Meeting agenda

The aim is that NAG meetings may only last an hour; therefore, presenters will be given a maximum of four (4) minutes to present their case. Responses are to be limited to two (2) minutes.

Each person sitting around the meeting table is there for a reason, so ensure everyone gets a chance to have their say and that no one shall dominate the conversation, constricting the enthusiasm and creativity of others.
